Want to enter? Follow the below guidelines to submit your artwork:

- Students must be between the ages of 14-18.
- Students must be in Montgomery County.
- Artwork must show a positive message that discourages substance abuse (specifically highlighting prevention and recovery) and encourages healthier lifestyles in our communities.
- Students cannot use **photographs that include other people** in their artwork.
- Artwork must be original. Students cannot use any copyrighted or trademarked characters (such as comic, television, or movie characters), logos, or trademarked names of specific products.
- Artwork must include the **SAMHSA** 24-hour national mental health and substance use helpline: **1-800-662-HELP (4357)**.
- Students cannot use political references, images, or messages.
- Students cannot use inappropriate or discriminatory language or symbols.
- The student's full name, age, grade, and the name of the school they attend must be included with submissions.
- Team entries are not allowed.
- One (1) entry per student will be allowed.

But what will you **win?**

- The first place winner will receive a \$200 Amazon gift card and their artwork will be displayed on various billboards in Montgomery County.
- The second place winner will receive a \$100 Amazon gift card and their artwork will be displayed on various transit shelters in Montgomery County.
- The third place winner will receive a \$50 Amazon gift card.
